

Introduction

This annual survey serves as a crucial tool for capturing the perspectives of our community. It plays a key role in bridging the communication gap between the Franconia Soaring Foundation (FSF) and the Franconia Soaring Association (FSA), ensuring that we effectively respond to and address the needs and concerns of our members.

Survey Overview

Statistics and Key Topics



- There were 19 survey respondents
- 13 of the 19 respondents were not members of the FSF board
- Average time to complete was 13 minutes 46 seconds
- The survey started Nov. 14th and concluded Dec. 1st
- All responses were anonymous

Quantity of Communications


How do you rate the quantity of communications from FSF to the Franconia soaring community?




Average rating is **3.26** and **3.30 (FSA)**Median is **3** for both

By which channels would you like to receive updates from the FSF? (Select all that apply)






All respondents want to receive updates through email

No respondents want updates through X (Twitter) and LinkedIn


Awareness and Utilization of Social Media

Which of the FSFs social media pages have you visited?




Knowledge of FSF Board Members

Do you know who in the FSA is also a member of the FSF Board?








Most of FSA respondents know a member on the FSF board

Community Involvement in Key Projects

I have discussed inputs on key projects, including the airport acquisition, the Training and Operations Center (TOC), and our Aviation STEM and glider programs with FSA members on the FSF Board.



- 74% of all respondents agree or are neutral
- 85% of FSA respondents agree or are neutral
- Only 3 respondents "disagree"
- No respondents "strongly disagree" 😉

Suggestions for TOC Improvement

If the answer to question 6 is "No", how do you suggest we modify the ultimate buildout of the TOC facility to meet those needs?

Membership: 10 years

"It's a marginal "no" because other than pictoral renderings of the building I haven't seen detailed plans as to how the space is to be dispositioned. Keeping the radio mast close to the radio which should be on the ground floor for immediate access (even easily accessible through an open window). The height of the roller doors is a bit low, which is too late to change? Heating of the lower level is imperative during winter months (occasionally) to allow maintenance to be carried out."

Membership: 8 years

"The building may be adequate - but we have heard that the "hangar" portion of the building will not hold the tow plane & may only hold private ship trailers?

Also - you can build it - but you must also staff the operation. Is FSF expecting FSA to do that?"

Suggestions for TOC Improvement

If the answer to question 6 is "No", how do you suggest we modify the ultimate buildout of the TOC facility to meet those needs?

Response: Disagree

"I say no only because I was not a party to developing nor hearing stated the objectives for the building, so it is not possible to opine on how it will meet those needs. The former building was highly accessible for folks running in and out countless times over the course of a day, and I question whether the new one will be so convenient."

"Please put a schematic or blueprint of the building on the FSF website. It's hard to comment on something you can't see or study."



All respondents want more detail on planning, maintenance, and operational goals


FSA Membership Length





Do you know when, how, and why the FSF was formed?




95% have at least some knowledge about this topic

Do you know what the many purposes of the FSF are, and how they have benefited and can benefit you and future generations of soaring enthusiasts?




All respondents have some awareness of FSF's benefits


